On Saturday 08-29-2020 at approximately 1932 hours, this officer was dispatched to 198 Worcester Street Reunion Tap & Grill.

Upon arrival, I entered the far-left entrance and I stopped my cruiser to listen to the live band. This noise was much louder than usual. On the same date at approximately 1815 hours, Officer John Ropiak and I were across the street at Five Star Liquor checking on a subject that could have been the subject Millbury Police Department put out a BOLO. The subject that Officer Ropiak observed was not the subject in question. We could hear the patrons and music. The level of noise was the normal level. While this officer was sitting listen to the loud music, we received a second call regarding the loud music playing. I observed one of the owners walking towards me and I drove up to meet with him. This owner was Sargon Hanna, I then engaged in conversation with Mr. Hanna and I advised him of the noise complaints. He advised this officer that it is a little louder than normal and the reason was there was a large anniversary party going on, it would be done at 9pm. I asked him to have the noise lowered, he promised this officer he would have it lower. As this officer was driving by, I observed the capacity of patrons was larger than normal.

At this time, I proceeded to speak with the reporting party. They both advised this officer that the noise was so loud that they had to close their windows to wind down their 15-month-old son and 4-year-old daughter for the evening. They further advised this officer that it was a beautiful night and they wanted their windows opened not closed with their air condition on. I advised them that of what Mr. Hanna stated to this officer and they stated they don't believe Mr. Hanna. I further advised them they can call the selectman's office and lodge a complaint with them as well.

I advised my dispatcher of the call and it was logged. No incident report was done at this time.

On this date at approximately 2016 hours, I was again dispatched to 198 Worcester Street Reunion Tap and Grill, the reporting party advised the noise did not decrease at all and reported they called the restaurant and spoke with a manger about turning it down. Upon my arrival, the noise from the live band was louder than before. I proceeded to the hostess station and I observed a young male host was dancing to the music. The crowd of patrons was more than usual. As this young male turned around, he immediately stopped dancing and I asked him where was Mr. Hanna. He advised this officer that he was inside. I then entered this building, I then engaged conversation with Mr. Hanna. He immediately stated the noise was not louder than before, I advised him to lower it immediately. I further advised him I would be doing an incident report and would forward it to Chief Creapeau. I then had conversation with my dispatcher and she advised this officer that the noise level was recorded on our recorded line from the caller and my radio transmission. I later sent an email to our department Administrate Secretary Marianne DeVries cc Chief Normand Crepeau to obtain and copy on a disk all calls and radio transmission, as soon as possible and forward the disk to the Chief so he can attach it to this incident report. While this officer was having conversation with Dispatcher Mercier, she advised that I must return to the station regarding a station call.

On this date at 2020 hours Officer Ropiak advised this officer that the noise level at Reunion Tap & Grill was still very loud and the capacity was more that it should be. At 2105 hours, this officer proceeded back to Reunion Tap & Grill the noise was lower the live band was not playing.
